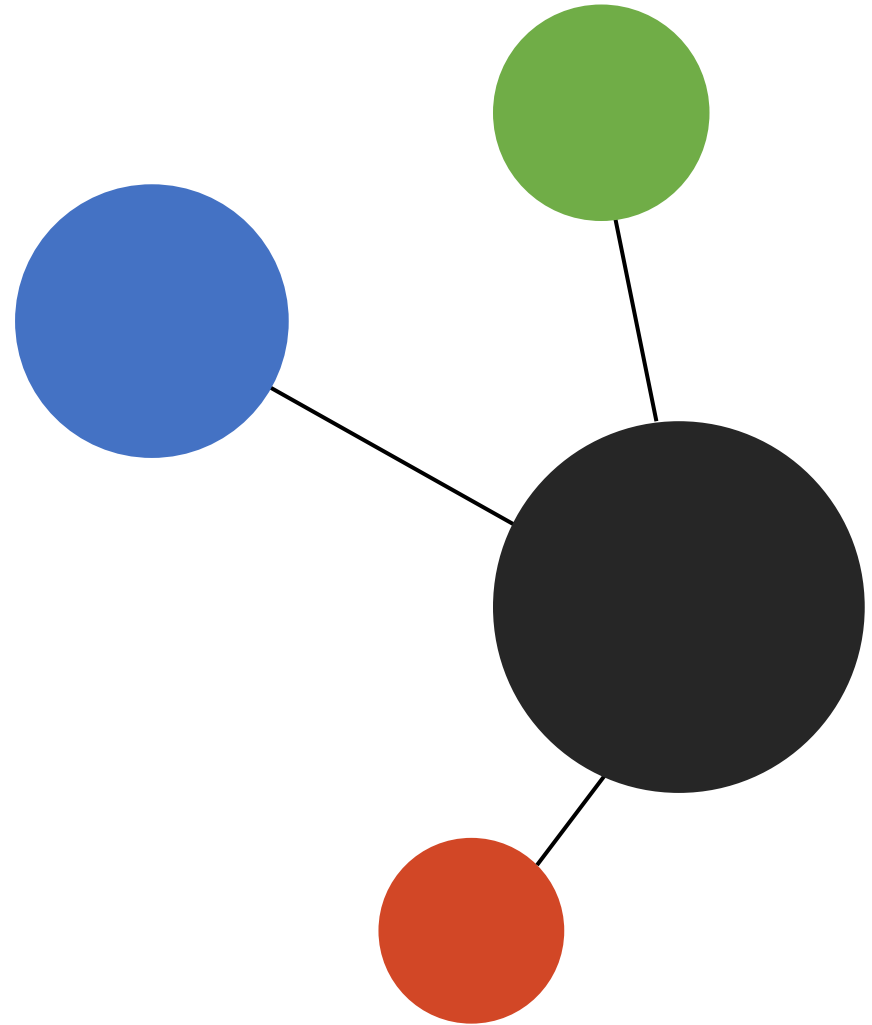




Health & Safety Map

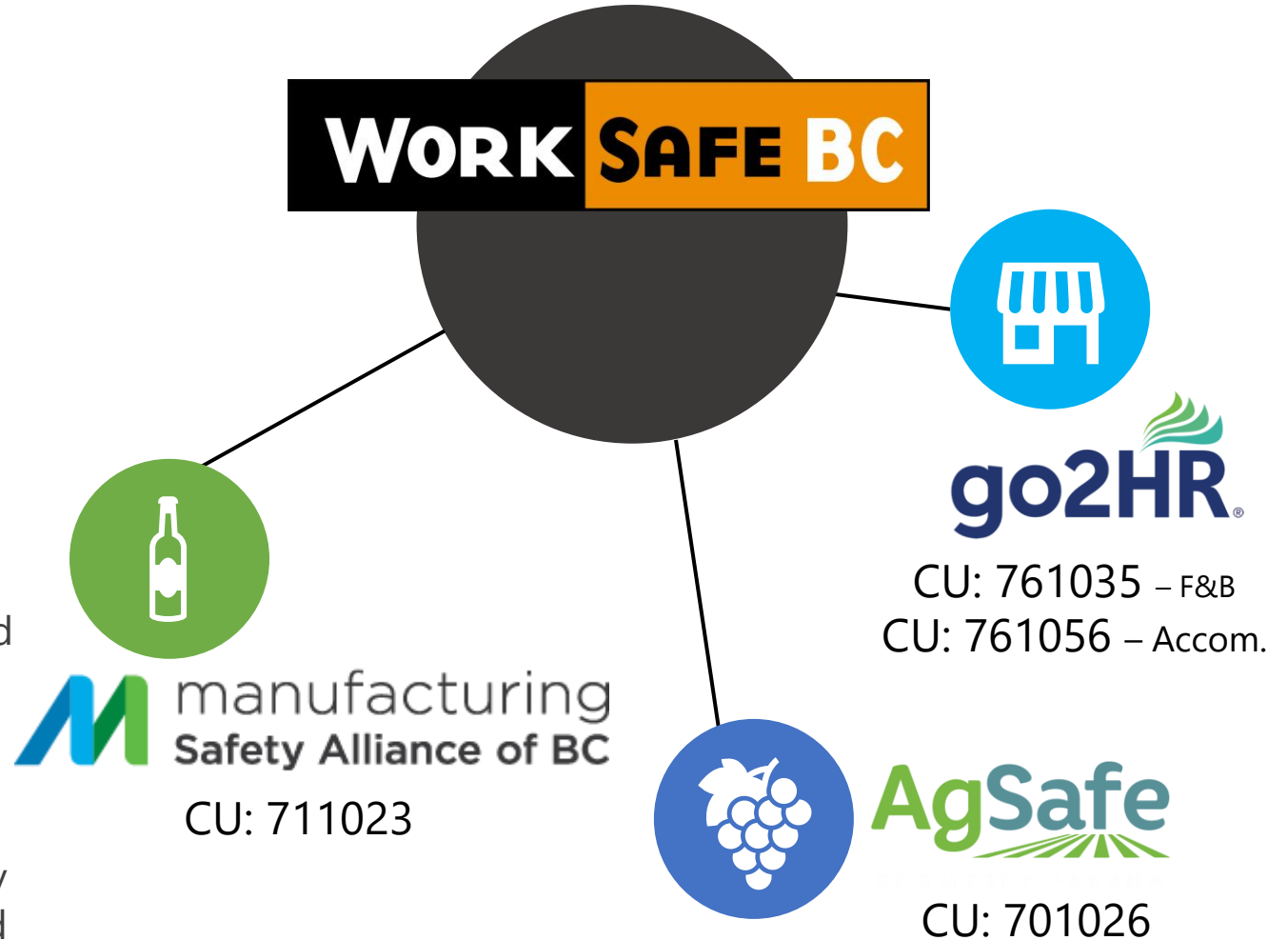
A tool for BC wineries and vineyards to identify resources that support their health and safety options.



Health & Safety Organizations

In BC, wineries, vineyards and tasting room operators have a network of organizations established to support H&S in their operations:

- **WorkSafeBC** – establishes the Health and Safety Association (HSA) based on a business's Classification Unit (CU).
 - Wineries (with or without vineyards and tasting rooms) are classified under CU (711023).
 - Vineyards (without an associated winery) are classified under CU (701026).
- **The Manufacturing Safety Alliance (MSA)** is funded to support Wineries.
- **AgSafe** is funded to support Vineyards that do not have a Winery.
- **go2HR** – is funded to support tourism and hospitality businesses, including accommodation (e.g. B&Bs) and food and beverage (e.g. restaurants, tasting rooms)

- 1 Navigate to the WorkSafeBC Questionnaire to determine your CU and identify hazards and risks that may exist in your industry

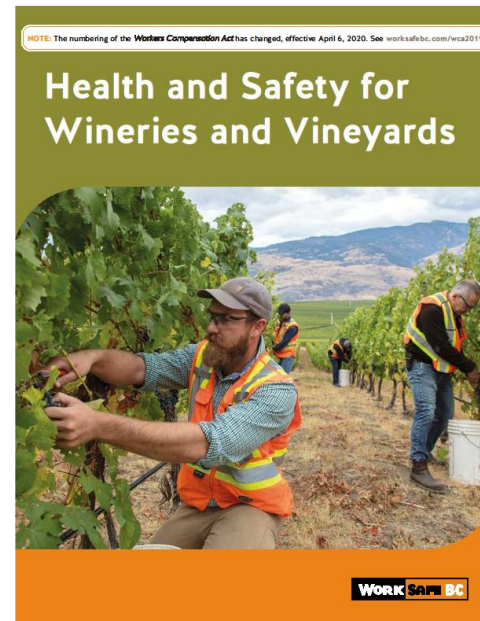
